## **Spring Message** Robert Fraser, Ph.D., CRC

As we move toward our Spring Gala auction, there is a lot occurring at NVSU. We thought we'd share some of these happenings:

- The State Vocational Rehabilitation system is in an Order of Selection, related to financial management, which means only the most severely disabled individuals can be referred for our vocational services. This underscores the importance of fund raising at our Gala to assist us until the state agency is again on stronger financial footing and can make more referrals to us.
- On a brighter note, our 2018 year was very successful with a 68% placement rate and one of our busiest and highest revenue years.
- Our PACES epilepsy self-management program, funded by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), showed significant impact at one year as to participants' medical and psychosocial management. The program is delivered by phone over eight sessions to small groups (5-8) of individuals with epilepsy. The national Epilepsy Foundation is now funding affiliates in other states to deliver the PACES program and negotiations are under way with pharmaceuticals to also fund its dissemination.
- Our staff is active and industrious. Dr. David Strand is attempting to expand our Tacoma services. Dora Fung is back after delivering a delightful little girl and leading the youth school to work transition effort. Barbara Beach continues to manage our inpatient vocational consultation services very effectively. Congratulations to Sydney McPhearson and her family on the delivery of two wonderful and healthy boy twins. The rest of us and our extremely bright Neuroscience interns (thanks to NVS support) "keep on keeping on!"

We look forward to a rich, but challenging 2019. Your financial support is greatly appreciated and don't forget us as a resource for funding excellent workers and also Temp-Perm personnel.

## **Annual Report in Review**

NVSU saw an increase in clients served with Head Injury/ Brain Tumors, ADHD/ Learning Disabilities comprising our highest percentage of clients served along with an increase in clients on the spectrum and those with physical disabilities. The education level of clients remains high with 24% having a Bachelor's degree.

Our job placement rate was 68%, a 12% increase over 2017. but there was also an increase from 3.84 months to placement in 2017 as compared to 4.31 in 2018. With the high employment rate in the greater Seattle area, our clients face strong competition in the job market. We continue to place clients with the following job titles: Attorney, Barista, Fulfillment Assoc., Cashier, Front Desk Rep, Kid zone Attendant.Marketing/Social Outreach and Online sales Manager, Package Handler, Quality Assurant Agent, Restaurant Host and Software Engineer.

Satisfaction remains high with client rating their satisfaction with NVSU services at 4.5, employers at 5 and DVR at 4.1 on a 5 point Likert Scale


